The government of the UIKA shall consist of a one house

Powers of Congress include:

- * Eliminate violence and other misdemeanors
- * Make good friendships
- * Run government properties
- * Appropriate government money for spending according to the President's ideas.
- * Propose and ratify amendments
- Citizenship laws
- * Act as a Supreme Court when needed

* Remove government officials for bad behavior based on voting.

A Congress member and the President can also be removed.

The Executive Branch is headed by the President of the UIKA, and it consists of the President, a vice president, a secretary, a technologist, an art director, a music director, website directors, a news host for the UIKA Pews Petwork, and indirectly, the temple pujaris. The President acts as treasurer and can make new posts and appointments. De/she can also negotiate treaties and suggest laws and amendments to Congress. The President has the right to resign and fire officials in the Executive Branch for bad behavior. To become the President if elected, one must recite this oath:

. Using other people's property or damaging it

. Using government property when unauthorized or damaging it

* Violation of any other freedoms or laws passed by Congress Prosecutions of all misdemeanors include a fine. They will also be told on to an adult. The adult will decide what to do with the verson.
